The bank balance is \$4282.26 with a book balance of \$4417.34. The difference is due to an outstanding cheque for the porta-potties of \$294.25, and the inclusion of the canteen profits which have not been turned in yet. The Fathers-day fun fly showed a profit of \$251.39 and the Electric Fun fly showed a profit of \$244.25. The grass cutting fees have not been paid yet.

C.F.I'S REPORT: Cliff Smith reported that Ron Belyea is ready for his flight test and Calvin Behm is also nearly ready after 5 nights of flying. Wilfred Hill reports that Jason Matheson is on the final stages of his wings program and just needs to nail his landings to be ready for his wings test.

MAINTENANCE & PROJECTS: Byron MacLean stated that the brick siding idea for the club house will not happen but that there is enough vinyl siding to cover the wooden portion of the club house. The siding is coloured "cape cod blue". Byron will bring some to the field to see how it will match the existing colour scheme. Byron mentioned that he has Jason Matheson's 2" foam insulation in his garage for members to use for projects. Gary Gorr is to check out the noticeable lean to the cook shack. Cliff Smith reported that one of the BBQ's is worn out, and Jason Matheson has offered us a used replacement.

OLD BUSINESS: The 2006 Fathers Day Fun Fly was a success. We had about 25 competitors, including 4 from our club. Our members did very well in the standings. Byron MacLean was given a very well done by the membership. Byron in turn thanked all those members who helped so willingly. Martin's Electric fun fly was well attended with about 60 participants. Martin thanked all those who helped. The Schneider cup scale air race event had about a dozen

people participating. Four scale planes attempted flight, but were unable to get off the water. The zone fun fly held at Brockville was a good event with more of our members flying than at our fun fly.

NEW BUSINESS: Final preparations are underway for the IMAA giant scale rally to be held at the field. Byron is planning on 60 for the Saturday evening dinner. Gary Gorr is to purchase 7 dozen ears of corn and Byron will organize getting a propane cooker to use. Cliff Smith is running the canteen, but is looking for lots of help. Byron MacLean put forward a motion for \$ 500.00 for food expenses. Motion seconded by Wilfred Hill. Approved. Gary Gorr seconded Cliff Smith's motion for \$ 500.00 for the canteen. Accepted. Jay Kingston has volunteered to operate the canteen for the Dawn Patrol event.
