Gary explained that there will be a full day of flying on Saturday until five P.M. and then open flying till dark. It was requested however, that priority be given to registered pilots. All radios including spread spectrum, will be impounded between flights. The transmitter impound will be self run on the honor system, and four flight stations will try to be operated at the runway fence. Another pilot who will act as safety observer will accompany each person flying. Take-offs, landings, and entry onto the field must be vocally announced. Ron Watts donated an "Almost Ready to Fly" Sig., electric Bristol Scout for dawn patrol. Cliff Smith will co-ordinate the operation of the canteen. Wilfred Hill will store the generator and PA system until after Dawn Patrol. Gary Vincent asked about the minimum height required for the safety barrier.
