C.F.I'S REPORT: Not presented, but Rolly Siemonsen presented Steve Haynes with his wings

MAINTENANCE & PROJECTS: It was pointed out that the interior of the clubhouse is in dire need of repairs. Gary Droppo presented a motion that when the fun fly financial statement is finished, that any monies over \$2000.00 in the fun fly account be used for repairs to the clubhouse. Motion seconded by Steve Haynes. Motion carried. Rolly proposed that up to \$1000.00 be used for clubhouse repairs. Motion seconded by Jim Thompson. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS: Gary Droppo on behalf of the "Dawn Patrol" executive presented the final report on the event. He thanked those who participated and those who help out. This was the third attempt at holding the event, and there seems to be a distinct lack of interest. For those who attended, there was good theme music, good flying and great food. The canteen and the 50/50 draw made money for the club. The three trophies bought for the event will be used for future events. Ron Watts and Leading Edge hobbies decided that we should use the kits that they donated, at our discretion.

NEW BUSINESS: Gary Droppo suggested that we raffle off the Balsa USA 40-sized Taube at the December meeting. In lieu of the monthly 50/50 draw, Wilfred Hill would sell \$1.00 draw tickets. Tickets would be sold at each meeting and at club events. Tickets would only be sold to KRCM members. Wilfred Hill asked if there was any interest in a fall club fun fly. October 21, 2007 was selected for the date of the event if it does not conflict with the MAAC zone meeting. Burgers would be provided for lunch with each member would provide their own refreshments. Peter Wagner recommended that the Sig electric Bristol Scout ARF kit be given to one of the participating club members. It was decided that the kit would be awarded based on a "Frequent Flyer" draw. At the end of each flight, and after returning your transmitter to the impound, you would put a signed ticket into a draw can. At the end of the event, one name would be drawn and that person presented with the kit. Mike Daicar needs to know the number of people who are interested in indoor flying so that he can arrange times with the dome. The club received a bill for \$227.90 from the Ernestown school board for the use of the Odessa high school gym for last seasons indoor flying. Gary Droppo made a motion that the use of the KRCM name for any use must be approved at a club meeting beforehand. Motion seconded by Ron Belyea, Carried. Martin Irvine proposed that if within one week the issue be not resolved by Byron MacLean, that the club pays the bill. Seconded by Ron Watts, carried.
