TREASURER'S REPORT: Presented by Rolly Siemonsen
We have a bank balance of \$3996.12 and a book balance of \$2611.12. The difference is due to a deposit of \$65.00 and a payment for grass cutting of \$1450.00. The poly-john, field taxes, and grass cutting have all been paid. We are still waiting for the invoice for the second poly-john used for the Electric fun Fly. It will cost about \$50.00 per month to maintain our poly-john during the balance of the year. The Fathers Day fun fly generated \$497.75 and the Electric fun fly made \$366.02. KRCM is now 78 members strong.

MAINTENANCE & PROJECTS: The field is in great shape. The new sod seems to have taken hold with all the recent rains. Cliff Smith recommended that when we repair the heaving patio stone sidewalk leading to the clubhouse, that we raise it level with the door to allow better wheel-chair access.

OLD BUSINESS: Rolly will send out the new link for E-Bay. The float fly was held on Sunday July 20th, 2008 with seven fliers present. The flying was great under very cloudy skies, with no crashes. It rained during the burger lunch

break, and flying resumed after lunch. Another float fly will be scheduled sometime in September. Martin Irvine was not present to give a report on the electric fun fly, but the financial report indicated that there was around 30 registered pilots to enjoy the great weather. Again this year they went out to Varty Lake to do some float flying.
