Cliff Smith has offered to pick up the parts needed to install the wood stove.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Four members attended the 2008 annual zone meeting. Safety and Insurance were the two main issues. MAAC will no longer sanction model- flying demonstrations in conjunction with full-scale aircraft shows. It was proposed that all MAAC sanctioned events employ a similar aircraft safety check sheet as used by IMAA. Jim Thompson proposed that the club by-laws be reviewed, as it has been quite a while since the last review. Gary reminded members that it is up to the membership to review the bylaws and make recommendations for changes.
