TREASURER'S REPORT: Presented by Rolly Siemonsen
The bank balance is \$5059.73 and the book balance is \$4984.73.
The difference is due to an outstanding cheque to MAAC.
We have 89 members, up by 6 from last year.

There was a motion to allocate \$500 for snow removal. This was based on the \$400 spent last year when the snow was removed by an on call basis. Rolly Siemonsen and Gary Vincent will each approach a separate supplier for a price per plowing.

MAINTENANCE & PROJECTS: Snow plowing will again be on an on call basis to keep costs down. There is sufficient firewood even without the missing oak.

OLD BUSINESS: Rene Lebrun has led negotiations for use of the Thompson Drill Hall for indoor flying. The cost will be \$140 for a three-hour session. There will be three 15-minute time slots one each for small planes, larger planes and helicopters. We need 14 attendees per session paying \$10 each to break even. We should promote the indoor flying to ensure we have enough participants. The schedule is on the web site and at Leading Edge Hobbies. There was an indoor fun fly last year and it is a good idea for this season to increase interest.

There was a concern of 450 size helicopters being flown close to spectators. It was decided to use the far end of the hall for them and barricade off the area from non-fliers.
